



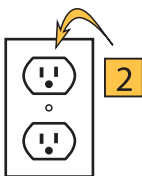

User Manual for the LMS-210 Portable Speaker



6 - STEP SETUP GUIDE

Step 1 Find the AC power cord to the LMS-210 and plug it into the back panel.

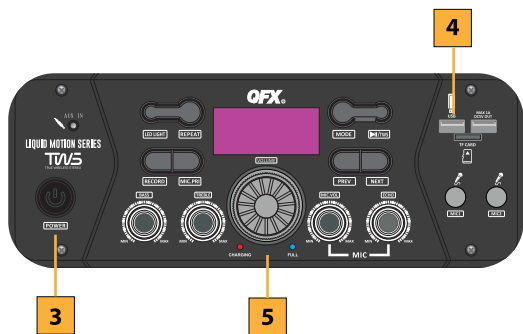
Step 2 Find a power outlet (AC 120V/60Hz) and connect the AC cord to the socket to supply the unit with power.

Step 3 Move to the top of part of the panel and press the POWER INPUT button. The unit should turn on and begin charging.

Step 4 Insert a USB flash drive in the USB port located below the big knob. The PBX-311 will automatically begin playing the .mp3 content.

Step 5 Use the Big Knob to adjust the Master Volume to your taste. Press the Big Knob to enter sub menus such as EQ, Mic Vol, Guitar VOL, Echo, etc.

Step 6 Press the Next and Prev keys to move to the next track or previous track. If in FM mode, these keys will change radio station.



LMS-210 BLUETOOTH

Bluetooth Mode: Use the MODE button to enable Bluetooth on the LMS-210. Open the Bluetooth settings on your mobile device and search for QFX LMS-210. Select the option to pair both devices together. You can now sit back and enjoy the music from your favorite app. You won't need reconnect the Bluetooth again when switching through modes.

LMS-210 FM RADIO:

FM Radio: Frequency-Modulated stations operate in a frequency band extending from 87.8 MHz to 108 MHz. Use the MODE button to select the FM mode. In FM mode, press and hold the Play/Pause button to scan available frequencies in the area. Extend the telescoping antenna to enhance reception.

LMS-210 TWS CONNECTION:

TWS Wireless Bluetooth Connection: Enable Bluetooth mode on both speakers. Press the **TWS** button on one of the speakers to sync both units (they must be the same make and model to function). On your mobile device under the Bluetooth menu, search for LMS-210 and connect. Open your favorite music app and enjoy True Wireless Stereo. To Exit TWS press and hold the **TWS** button.

LMS-210 RECORDING

Insert a USB/TF card in the slot. Connect the microphone to the LMS-210. Press and hold the "RECORD" button to start recording. Press the "RECORD" again to playback the recorded file. Press again to exit the recording function.



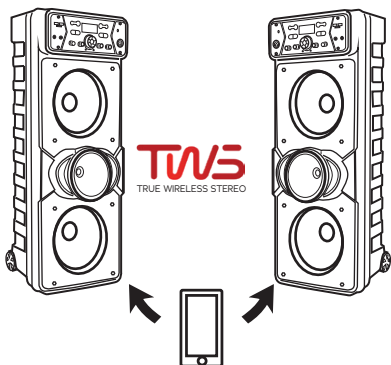
LMS-210 BATTERY

The LMS-210 is a aluminum Iron Phosphate battery powered PA loudspeaker.

Be sure that you have completely charged the battery prior to first use to maximize the battery's lifespan. Once the power cable is connected to a power source, it will automatically begin charging (4~5hours to fully charge the battery) Even if the battery power is low, it will power on when connected to a power source. When the battery is charging, the battery indicator light will shine red. When battery is fully charged, the battery indicator light will shine blue. Once the unit is fully charged, please disconnect the cable. With standard usage, a fully charged battery can play for about 2~3 hours. Battery can be recharged about 300 times in its lifetime. When not in use, the speaker should always be turned OFF to prevent the unit from draining its battery. When the unit is not used for prolonged periods of time, the battery will gradually lose its power. It is recommended to fully charge the battery at least every 60 days.

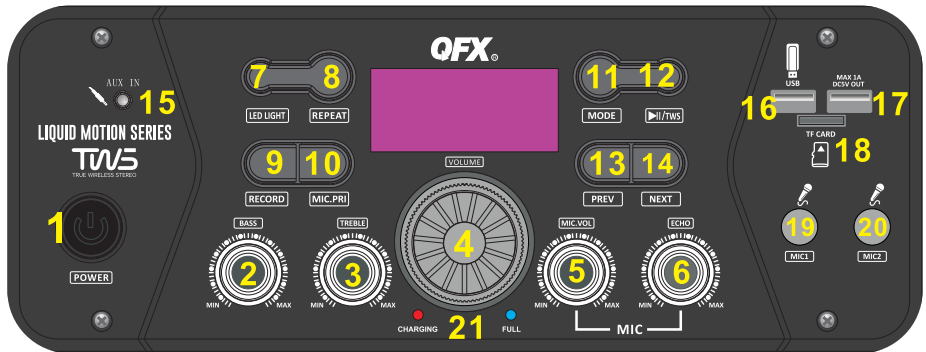
TWS CONNECTION

3. On your mobile device under the Bluetooth menu, search for LMS-210 and connect.
4. Open your favorite music app and enjoy True Wireless Stereo.
5. To Exit TWS press and hold the **TWS** button.

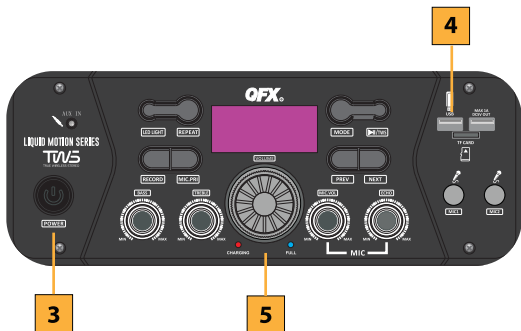
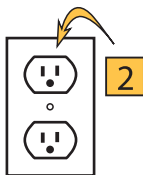


LMS-210 DISPLAY

6 - GUÍA DE CONFIGURACIÓN DE PASOS

Paso **1** Busque el cable de alimentación de CA al LMS-210 y conéctelo al panel posterior.

Paso **2** Busque una toma de corriente (CA 120V / 60Hz) y conecte el cable de CA al enchufe para suministrar energía a la unidad.

Paso **3** Vaya a la parte superior de parte del panel y presione el botón POWER INPUT. La unidad debe encenderse y comenzar a cargarse.

Paso **4** Inserte una unidad flash USB en el puerto USB ubicado debajo de la perilla grande. El LMS-210 automáticamente comenzará a reproducir el contenido .mp3.

Paso **5** Utilice el mando grande para ajustar el volumen principal a su gusto. Presione el botón grande para ingresar a los submenús como EQ, Mic Vol, Guitar VOL, Echo, etc.

Paso **6** Pulse las teclas de avance y retroceso para pasar a la siguiente pista o pista anterior. Si está en modo FM, estas teclas cambiarán la estación de radio.

LMS-210 BLUETOOTH

Modo Bluetooth: use el botón MODE para habilitar Bluetooth en el LMS-210. Abra la configuración de Bluetooth en su dispositivo móvil y busque QFX LMS-210. Seleccione la opción para emparejar ambos dispositivos. Ahora puede sentarse y disfrutar de la música de su aplicación favorita. No necesitará volver a conectar el Bluetooth al cambiar de modo.

RADIO FM LMS-210:

Radio FM: Las estaciones de frecuencia modulada operan en una banda de frecuencia que se extiende desde 87,8 MHz a 108 MHz. Utilice el botón MODE para seleccionar el modo FM. En el modo FM, mantenga presionado el botón Reproducir / Pausa para buscar las frecuencias disponibles en el área. Extienda la antena telescópica para mejorar la recepción.

CONEXIÓN LMS-210 TWS:

Conexión inalámbrica Bluetooth TWS: habilite el modo Bluetooth en ambos altavoces. Presione el botón TWS en uno de los altavoces para sincronizar ambas unidades (deben ser de la misma marca y modelo para funcionar). En su dispositivo móvil en el menú de Bluetooth, busque LMS-210 y conéctese. Abra su aplicación de música favorita y disfrute de True Wireless Stereo. Para salir de TWS, mantenga presionado el botón TWS.

GRABACIÓN LMS-210

Inserte una tarjeta USB / TF en la ranura. Conecte el micrófono al LMS-210. Mantenga presionado el botón "RECORD" para comenzar a grabar. Presione "RECORD" nuevamente para reproducir el archivo grabado. Presione nuevamente para salir de la función de grabación.



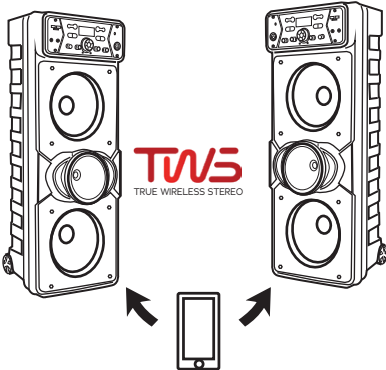
BATERÍA LMS-210

El LMS-210 es un altavoz PA alimentado por batería de fosfato de hierro de aluminio.

Asegúrese de haber cargado completamente la batería antes del primer uso para maximizar la vida útil de la batería. Una vez que el cable de alimentación está conectado a una fuente de alimentación, comenzará a cargarse automáticamente (4 ~ 5 horas para cargar completamente la batería) Incluso si la carga de la batería es baja, se encenderá cuando se conecte a una fuente de alimentación. Cuando la batería se está cargando, la luz indicadora de la batería se iluminará en rojo. Cuando la batería está completamente cargada, la luz indicadora de la batería se iluminará en azul. Una vez que la unidad esté completamente cargada, desconecte el cable. Con el uso estándar, una batería completamente cargada puede funcionar durante aproximadamente 2 ~ 3 horas. La batería se puede recargar unas 300 veces durante su vida útil. Cuando no esté en uso, el altavoz siempre debe estar APAGADO para evitar que la unidad agote la batería. Cuando la unidad no se utiliza durante períodos prolongados de tiempo, la batería perderá gradualmente su carga. Se recomienda cargar completamente la batería al menos cada 60 días.



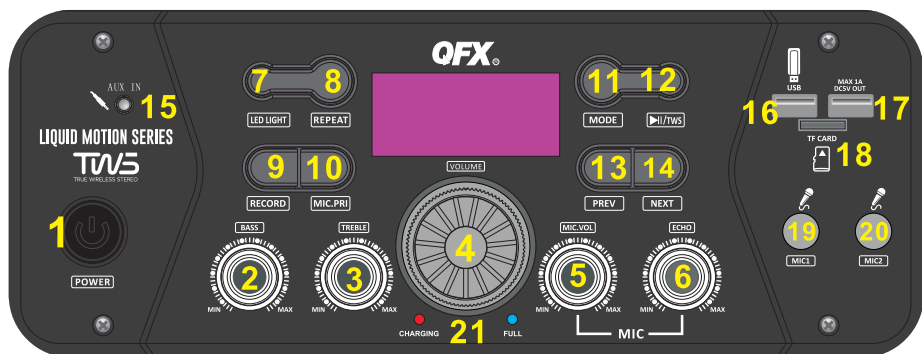

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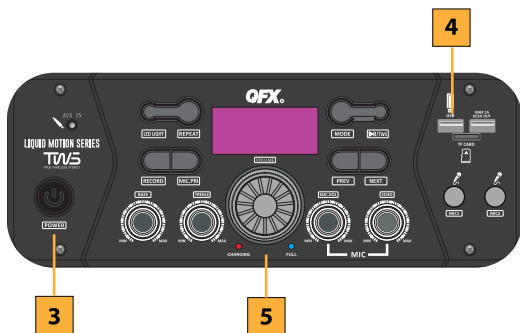
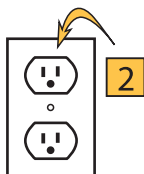

6 - GUIDE DE CONFIGURATION DES ÉTAPES

Étape **1** Trouvez le cordon d'alimentation secteur du LMS-210 et branchez-le sur le panneau arrière.

Étape **2** Trouvez une prise de courant (120 V CA / 60 Hz) et branchez le cordon d'alimentation CA à la prise pour alimenter l'unité.

Étape **3** Déplacez-vous vers le haut d'une partie du panneau et appuyez sur le bouton POWER INPUT. L'unité doit s'allumer et commencer à se charger.

Étape **4** Insérez une clé USB dans le port USB situé sous le gros bouton. Le LMS-210 commencera automatiquement la lecture du contenu .mp3.

Étape **5** Utilisez le gros bouton pour régler le volume principal à votre goût. Appuyez sur le gros bouton pour accéder aux sous-menus tels que EQ, Mic Vol, Guitar VOL, Echo, etc.

Étape **6** Appuyez sur les touches Avance et Retour pour passer à la piste suivante ou à la piste précédente. En mode FM, ces touches changeront la fonction radio.

LMS-210 BLUETOOTH

Mode Bluetooth: utilisez le bouton MODE pour activer Bluetooth sur le LMS-210. Ouvrez les paramètres Bluetooth sur votre appareil mobile et recherchez QFX LMS-210. BATTERIE LMS-210

Le LMS-210 est un haut-parleur PA alimenté par batterie en aluminium phosphate de fer. Assurez-vous que vous avez complètement chargé la batterie avant la première utilisation afin de maximiser la durée de vie de la batterie. Une fois que le câble d'alimentation est connecté à une source d'alimentation, il commencera automatiquement à se charger (4 à 5 heures pour charger complètement la batterie) Même si la batterie est faible, il s'allumera lorsqu'il est connecté à une source d'alimentation. Lorsque la batterie est en charge, le voyant de la batterie s'allume en rouge. Lorsque la batterie est complètement chargée, le voyant de la batterie s'allume en bleu. Une fois l'appareil complètement chargé, veuillez déconnecter le câble. Avec une utilisation standard, une batterie complètement chargée peut fonctionner pendant environ 2 à 3 heures. La batterie peut être rechargée environ 300 fois au cours de sa vie. Lorsqu'elle n'est pas utilisée, le haut-parleur doit toujours être éteint pour éviter que l'appareil ne décharge sa batterie. Lorsque l'appareil n'est pas utilisé pendant des périodes prolongées, la batterie perd progressivement sa puissance. Il est recommandé de charger complètement la batterie au moins tous les 60 jours.



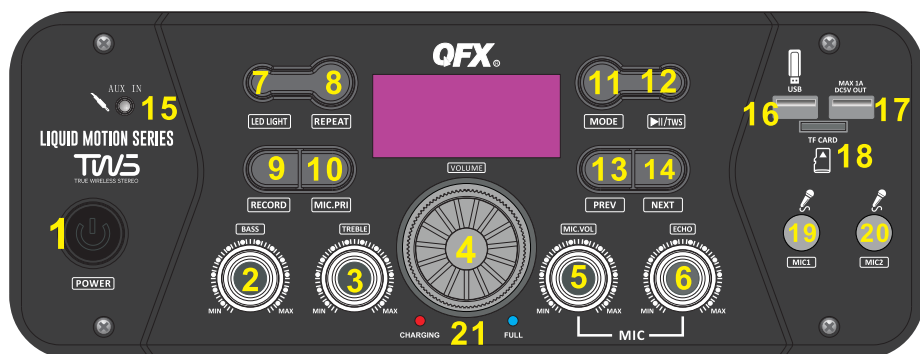
