BATTERY

The TMS-1253 is a rechargeable battery powered PA loudspeaker. Be sure that you have completely charged the battery prior to first use to maximize the battery's lifespan. Once the power adaptor is connected to a power source, it will automatically begin charging (4-5 hours to fully charge the battery) Even if the battery power is low, it will power on when connected to a power source. When the battery is charging, the battery indicator light is red. When the battery charge fully, the indicator light will turn off. Upon completion of the charging, please disconnect the unit. When not in use, the speaker should always be set OFF to prevent the unit from draining the battery. When the unit is not used for prolonged periods of time, the battery will gradually lose its power. It is recommended to fully charge the battery at least every 60 days. When battery is completely empty, the unit cannot perform at 100% of the volume when immediately connected to power source. It is suggested to charge for a while before using with 100% volume. The unit may work and charge with lower-level volume. The volume level would be increased as the unit is charging.

BATERÍA

El TMS-1253 es un altavoz PA con batería recargable. Asegúrese de haber cargado completamente la batería antes del primer uso para maximizar su vida útil. Una vez que el adaptador de corriente esté conectado a una fuente de alimentación, comenzará a cargarse automáticamente (4-5 horas para cargar completamente la batería). Incluso si la carga de la batería es baja, se encenderá cuando se conecte a una fuente de alimentación. Cuando la batería se está cargando, la luz indicadora de la batería está roja. Cuando la batería se cargue por completo, la luz indicadora se apagará. Al finalizar la carga, desconecte la unidad. Cuando no esté en uso, el altavoz siempre debe estar APAGADO para evitar que la unidad agote la batería. Cuando la unidad no se utiliza durante períodos prolongados de tiempo, la batería perderá energía gradualmente. Se recomienda cargar completamente la batería al menos cada 60 días. Cuando la batería está completamente vacía, la unidad no puede funcionar al 100% del volumen cuando se conecta inmediatamente a la fuente de alimentación. Se sugiere cargar durante un tiempo antes de usarlo con el 100% del volumen. La unidad puede funcionar y cargarse con un volumen de nivel más bajo. El nivel de volumen aumentará a medida que la unidad se esté cargando.

BATTERIE

Le TMS-1253 est un haut-parleur de sonorisation alimenté par batterie rechargeable. Assurez-vous d'avoir complètement chargé la batterie avant la première utilisation afin de maximiser la durée de vie de la batterie. Une fois que l'adaptateur secteur est connecté à une source d'alimentation, il commencera automatiquement à se charger (4-5 heures pour charger complètement la batterie). Même si la batterie est faible, il s'allumera lorsqu'il sera connecté à une source d'alimentation. Lorsque la batterie est en charge, le voyant de la batterie est rouge. Lorsque la batterie est complètement chargée, le voyant s'éteint. Une fois la charge terminée, veuillez débrancher l'appareil. Lorsqu'il n'est pas utilisé, le haut-parleur doit toujours être éteint pour éviter que l'appareil ne décharge la batterie. Lorsque l'appareil n'est pas utilisé pendant une période prolongée, la batterie perd progressivement sa puissance. Il est recommandé de charger complètement la batterie au moins tous les 60 jours. Lorsque la batterie est complètement vide, l'appareil ne peut pas fonctionner à 100 % du volume lorsqu'il est immédiatement connecté à une source d'alimentation. Il est suggéré de charger pendant un certain temps avant de l'utiliser avec un volume de 100 %. L'appareil peut fonctionner et se charger avec un volume inférieur. Le niveau de volume augmenterait à mesure que l'appareil est en charge.

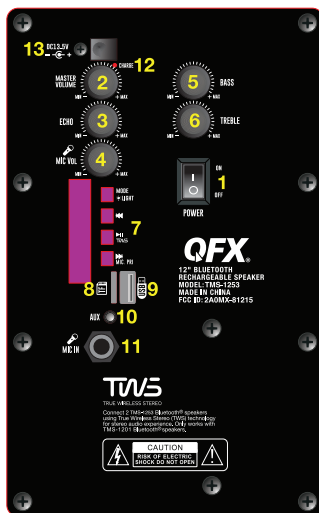

TMS-1253 Back Panel Controls

1. **POWER:** ON / OFF Power Switch
2. **VOLUME:** Master Volume Control Knob
3. **ECHO:** Mic Echo Control Knob
4. **MIC.VOL:** Microphone Volume Control
5. **BASS:** Bass Control Knob
6. **TREBLE:** Treble Control Knob
7. **MODE:**
 - a. Press to toggle AUX, USB, TF, FM Radio and Bluetooth modes.

DISPLAY

The LED screen will display the following information:

- Input Mode (displays USB, TF, Bluetooth, AUX or FM)
- When the USB drive or TF card is inserted, it will switch to USB/TF mode and begin playing your MP3 formatted music files. The track number currently playing from the USB/TF will be displayed.
- In FM radio mode, the FM radio station channels will be displayed. Press the Play/Pause button while in FM mode to auto-scan and save the radio stations received in your area.

REMOTE CONTROL

1. **STANDBY:** Make the unit to be standby mode.
2. **Input Mode Button:** Toggle between USB, TF, FM, AUX, and BT.
3. **Mute:** Mute the track volume.
4. **PLAY/PAUSE:** Play or pause music.
5. **Previous Track:** Select previous channel.
6. **Next Track:** Select next channel.
7. **EQ:** Select EQ mode.
8. **VOL-:** Reduce the master volume.
9. **VOL+:** Increase the master volume.
10. **REP:** Repeat the playing track.

BLUETOOTH

Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device. On the device, find "QFX TMS-1253" to connect. After successful pairing, you can stream music wirelessly from our Bluetooth device.

TRUE WIRELESS STEREO (TWS)

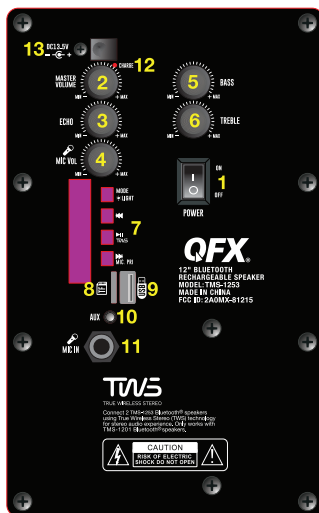
Two TMS-1253 QFX speakers can pair via Bluetooth to deliver True Wireless Stereo (TWS) sound.

To do so:

1. Turn both speakers power ON
2. Select Bluetooth mode on both speakers
3. Press the Play/Pause button on one speaker only for 3 seconds. Then the speakers will connect together.
4. Next, to connect to your Bluetooth device, search for the QFX model number (QFX TMS-1253)
5. After successful pairing, you can stream music wirelessly from your Bluetooth device to both speakers in True Wireless Stereo (TWS).
6. Press-and-hold TWS to exit True Wireless Stereo mode.

PANTALLA

La pantalla LED mostrará la siguiente información:

- Modo de entrada (muestra USB, TF, Bluetooth, AUX o FM)
- Cuando se inserte la unidad USB o la tarjeta TF, cambiará al modo USB/TF y comenzará a reproducir sus archivos de música en formato MP3. Se mostrará el número de pista que se está reproduciendo actualmente desde USB/TF.
- En modo de radio FM, se mostrarán los canales de estación de radio FM. Presione el botón de Reproducir/Pausa mientras está en modo FM para hacer una búsqueda automática y guardar las estaciones de radio recibidas en su área.

BLUETOOTH

Activa Bluetooth en tu dispositivo móvil. Luego, busca "QFX TMS-1253" en el dispositivo para conectar. Después de emparejar correctamente, podrás transmitir música de forma inalámbrica desde nuestro dispositivo Bluetooth.

TRUE WIRELESS STEREO (TWS)

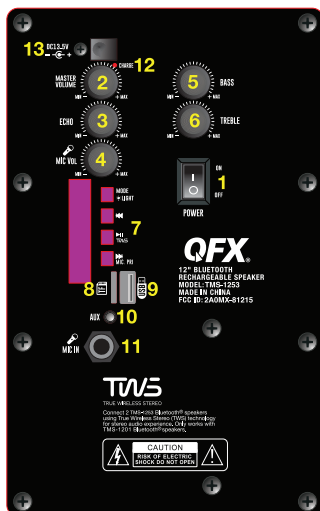
Dos altavoces QFX TMS-1253 pueden emparejarse vía Bluetooth para proporcionar sonido estéreo verdadero inalámbrico (TWS).

Para hacerlo:

1. Enciende ambos altavoces.
2. Selecciona el modo Bluetooth en ambos altavoces.
3. Presiona el botón de Reproducir/Pausa en solo uno de los altavoces durante 3 segundos. Luego, los altavoces se conectarán entre sí.
4. A continuación, para conectar tu dispositivo Bluetooth, busca el número de modelo (QFX TMS-1253).
5. Después de emparejar correctamente, podrás transmitir música de forma inalámbrica desde tu dispositivo Bluetooth a ambos altavoces en modo estéreo verdadero inalámbrico (TWS).

L'écran LED affichera les informations suivantes :

- Mode d'entrée (affiche USB, TF, Bluetooth, AUX ou FM)
- Lorsque la clé USB ou la carte TF est insérée, elle passe en mode USB/TF et commence à lire vos fichiers musicaux au format MP3. Le numéro de la piste en cours de lecture depuis l'USB/TF sera affiché.
- En mode radio FM, les chaînes des stations de radio FM seront affichées. Appuyez sur le bouton Lecture/Pause en mode FM pour rechercher et enregistrer automatiquement les stations de radio reçues dans votre région.

Deux haut-parleurs TMS-1253 QFX peuvent être couplés via Bluetooth pour offrir un son True Wireless Stereo (TWS).
