**1.1 Boot And Shutdown**

Start	Plug in the car key, turn on the ACC, the device will start automatically and show the boot logo animation.
To turn off	After removing the car key and turning off the ACC, the device will turn off automatically.

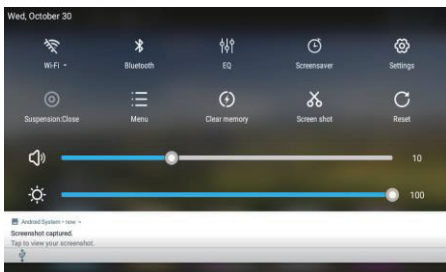
**1.2 Main Interface And Application Interface.**

The car status bar and drop down menu functions are as follows:

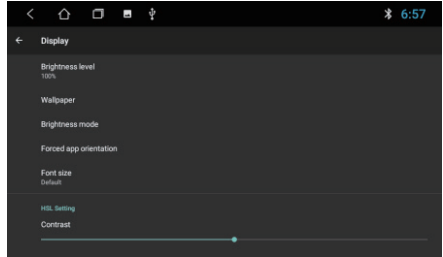
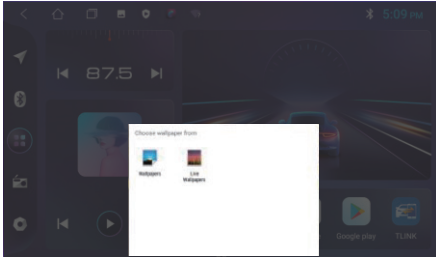

## 1.4 Wallpaper Replacement

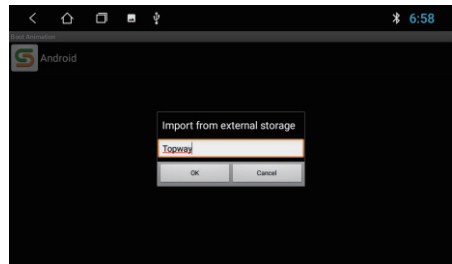
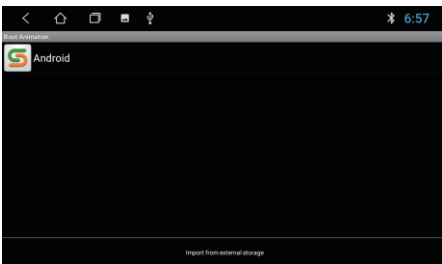
There are two ways to set the wallpaper:

1. When you long press the blank space of the main interface, the message “Select The “Wallpaper Source” box will appear.
2. In Settings -> Display -> Wallpaper, choose the wallpaper source according to your personal preferences.




## 1.5 Boot Animation Settings

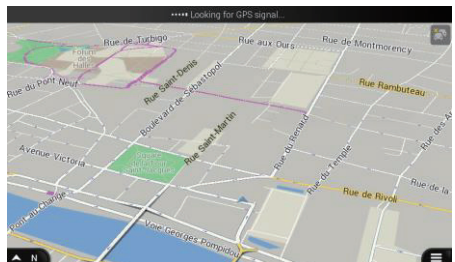
1. Open the application interface to access the [startup animation]. Choose an animation and click to confirm the change.
2. For custom animations: Copy the animation file to the root directory of the SD card or car USB disk. Click the “Menu button” in the drop-down bar to display the “Import from external storage” option. A password box will appear; Enter “Topway” to import the animation file from the USB disk. Select and confirm the replacement.



## 2.1 Navigation Function

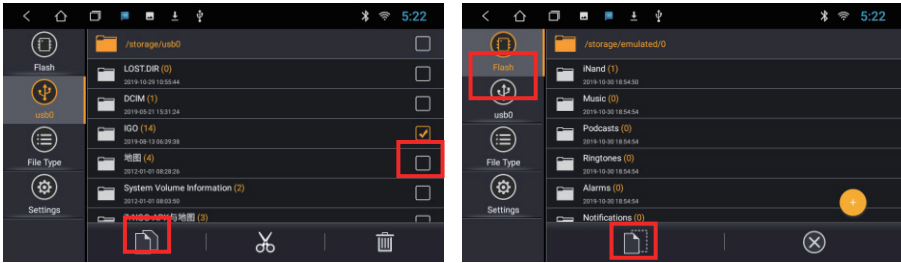
### 2.1.1 Use of maps

main interface click the navigation icon [  ] or in the application interface click the navigation function to enter the map interface



## 2.1.2 Copy And Install Maps

1. How to copy and install if the car has no map? The following OIG maps are given as examples.
2. Copy the map package and APK to SD card or USB flash drive (example of copy to USB flash drive)
3. Click [ ] to enter the application interface, open [File Manager], the left directory can see the USB disk path

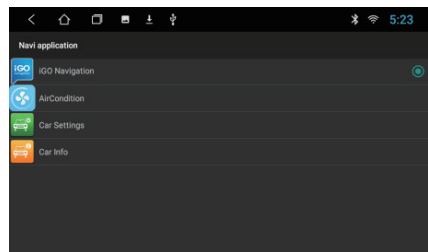
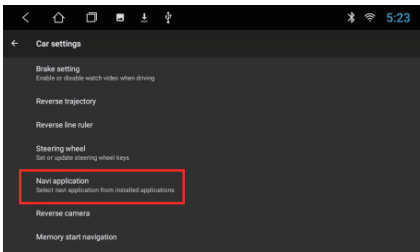


4. Insert the USB disk, check the map data package and APK, click [Copy] in the lower left corner; change to "Local" directory, click [Paste] in the lower left corner. It is estimated that the copy will take 10 minutes. After the copy is completed, click the map APK to install it.

## 2.1.3 Navigation Route Selection

After copying the offline map data and installing the map APK associate the navigation icons of the main interface:

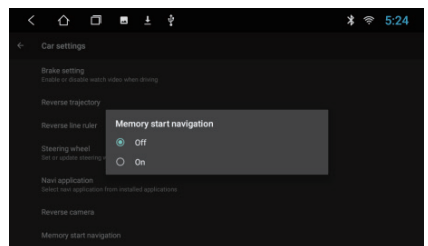
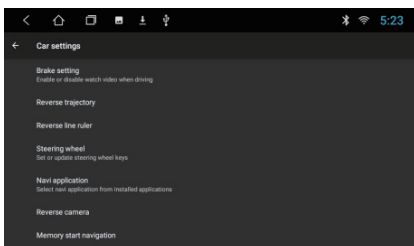
Settings -> Car Settings -> Navigation software, find IGO map and click to select.



## 2.1.4 Navigation Start

How to show map interface after boot?

1. Settings->Car settings->Start navigation, the default is off, set to open.
2. You need to close the ACC in the map interface; Otherwise, you will not enter the navigation interface.

Press the radio function on the main interface or APP interface to enter the radio interface:



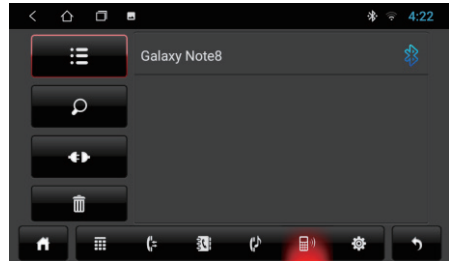
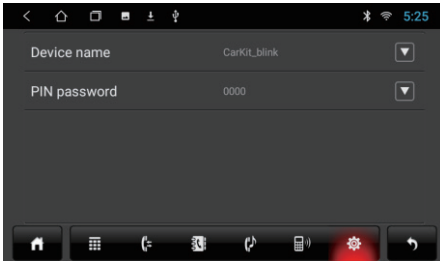

## 2.3 Bluetooth Function

Press the Bluetooth function to enter the Bluetooth interface

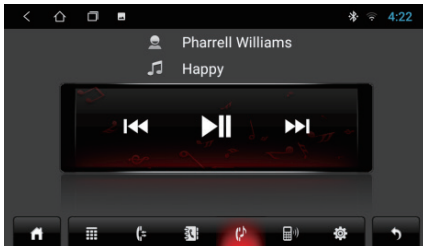
### 2.3.1 Paired devices

- When your device is not yet paired, you can only access the settings and search interface.
- In the pairing interface, press to search for nearby devices. Select the device you want to pair and the phone will display a PIN code box. Enter the PIN code and the icon will indicate that the connection was successful.




### 2.3.2 Bluetooth Music

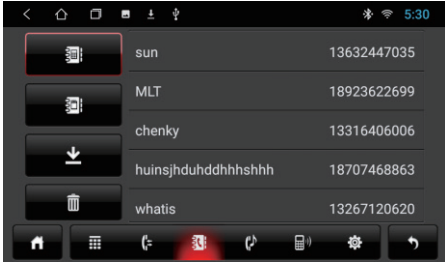
Click the icon to enter the music player interface. After connecting with the phone, you can operate the [Play & Pause] and [Previous/Next] functions.







Note: When using the Bluetooth music function, the music player of some mobile phones needs to open the music page from the mobile phone first.

### 2.3.3 Bluetooth Address Book

1. Bluetooth interface, click [  ] to enter the address book interface.
2. Download step: Select Phone/SIM; Click the Download button] to confirm the box sync address book request.



To find a contact: After syncing the address book, click the corresponding phone/SIM button and a search box will appear.

### 3.1 Dialing And Calling Functions

Dialing function

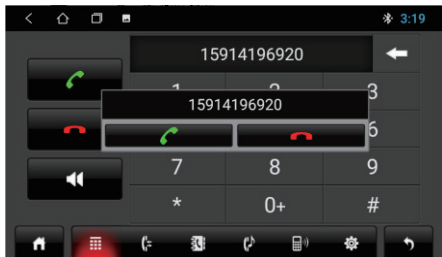
Click [  ] to enter the Bluetooth dialing interface and enter the number you want to dial.



1. Click the number to enter the phone number, enter the error and click [  ] to remove it bit by bit.
- 2 After entering the number, click [  ] Dial; [  ] ends the current call. When you are on a call, [  ] changes to a mobile phone call.

### 3.2 Call Function

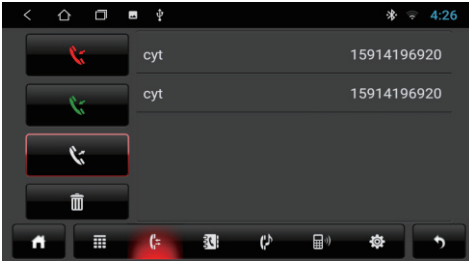
When the mobile phone book or an unknown number is not downloaded, the caller can only display the phone number. However, after downloading, the contact name will be shown when a call is made.



Note: The small floating window automatically disappears after the call ends.

### 3.3 Call History

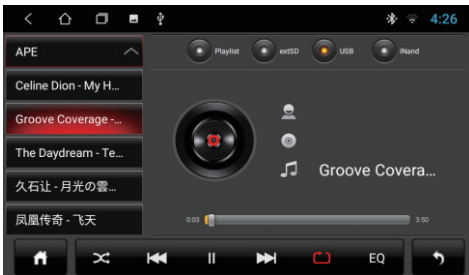
1. Press **[F6]** to enter the call history interface, only call history is synchronized when Bluetooth is paired.
2. Call log interface, click the contact in the list to broadcast the call

### 4.1 Music Function

Press the music icon button to enter the music player interface.

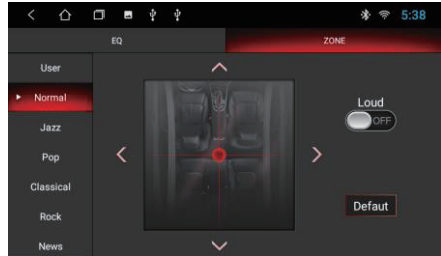
### 4.3 Equalizer (EQ)

There are two ways to enter the EQ interface:

- 1.APP interface, click [EQ] to enter equalizer settings
2. Click [EQ] on the radio and music interface to enter the equalizer setting interface.

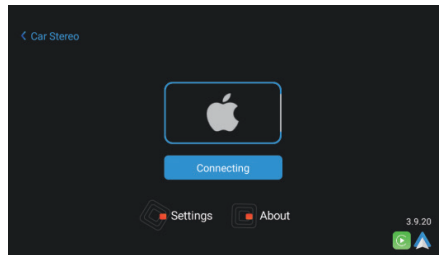
Rating: equalizer and sound field settings

- 1.Equalizer settings with 8 sound effects to choose from
- 2.Sound field settings, the user can freely adjust the bass contrast and volume, and adjust the volume of the front left, front right, rear left and rear right four directions.



### 4.3 Third Party Application - TLINK

After successful activation, the TLINK connection interface will display a mark in the lower right corner corresponding to the activated packet. The illustration below indicates support for full-featured automatic wired CarPlay+. Please note that activating wired CarPlay+Auto will result in only the last two icons being displayed in this interface. If the interface still does not display after successful activation, please restart the car.
