





## KAR-929 BLUETOOTH

**Bluetooth Mode:** Use the MODE button to enable Bluetooth on the KAR-929. Open the Bluetooth settings on your mobile device and search for QFX KAR-929. Select the option to pair both devices together. You can now sit back and enjoy the music from your favorite app. You won't need reconnect the Bluetooth again when switching through modes.

## KAR-929 Wi-Fi Setup:

**SETUP:** Press the SETUP key on the remote control directly to enter Settings, or press the direction keys to light the Settings icon. Press OK key to enter the selected page. After entering the Settings, press the Direction key to choose WIFI and to choose your network. Press the OK key and enter the Password to connect to the network.

## 6 - STEP SETUP GUIDE

**Step 1** Find the AC power cord to the KAR-929 located in the packaging and plug it in to DC IN.

**Step 2** Find a power outlet (AC 120V/60Hz) and connect the AC adapter to the socket to supply the unit with power.

**Step 3** Move to the top of part of the panel and press and hold the POWER INPUT button. The unit should turn on and begin charging.

**Step 4** Insert a USB flash drive in the USB port located next to the volume knob. The KAR-929 will automatically begin playing the .mp3 content.

**Step 5** Use the Volume knob to adjust the the overall volume to your taste. Use the Mic Volume knob to raise the mic.

**Step 6** Press the Forward and Rewind keys to move to the next track or previous track. If in FM mode, these keys will change radio sation.




1. MIC/MODE : Microphone mode Switch.
2. VOD: Enter On-Demand programs.
3. APPLY: Enter Application tore.
4. MUTE: Press the MUTE to be quiet.
5. SETUP: Enter the setup menu.
6. VOL+: Increase the Volume.
7. VOL - : Decrease the Volume.
8. TF/USB: Select TF/USB Function
9. DIRECTION KEY: Up, Down, Left, Right.
10. EXIT: Go back to the previous page.
11. OK: Confirmation key.
12. 0-9: Number keys.
13. TRACK: Track Selector.
14. MIC/PRIOR: Microphone priority Switch.
15. HOME: Return to the Homepage.
16. REPEAT: Alter the playing in single cycle or in all cycle.
17. Next: Enter next track.
18. PREV: Enter the last track.
19. LIVE: Live video streaming. Enter live programs.



1. Diaphragm: Speak Into the Diaphragm to transmit your voice to the KAR-929

2. ON/MUTE/OFF Switch: Activate the microphone, mute, or turn OFF the mic using the switch.

3. Battery Compartment: Twist to open and install 2 x AA batteries (batteries not included)

4. Transmitter: Keep the transmitter pointed at the KAR-929 and cleared from obstacles for the best reception.




1. For battery installation, twist the battery compartment to the Left to open.

2. Install 2xAA batteries and make sure the +/- are installed correctly. Follow the printed symbols on the mic.




1. POWER ON/OFF: Power On or Off.
2. LIGHTS ON/OFF: Turn lights On or Off.
3. MIC INPUT: Microphone input jack. Insert a 6.35mm TRS.
4. OGT: For factory computer upgrades.
5. Mini mic: Mini microphone input connection 3.5mm.
6. MIC VOL: Use this key to adjust the microphone sound volume, turn left to lower the volume, turn right to raise the volume.
7. Audio out : Audio output.
8. Audio in : Audio input.
9. ECHO: Use this key to adjust the microphone Echo. Turn left to lower the volume, turn right to raise the volume. Adjust the echo according to the surroundings.
10. TF: TF Card input.
11. BASS: Use this key to adjust the bass volume. Turn left to lower the volume, turn right to raise the volume.
12. HDMI out: HDMI output.
13. TREBLE: Use this key to adjust the treble volume. Turn left to lower the volume, turn right to raise the volume.
14. USB: USB input.
15. POWER SUPPLY: DC 9V input.
16. CHG: Charge indicator.
17. DC 12V INPUT: External connection battery input for external 12 V current source
18. VOL: Use this key to adjust the main volume. Turn left to lower the volume, right to raise the volume.
19. BT: Press to automatically enter the Bluetooth® function.
20. Audio track: Choose the left channel or the right channel or both.
21. MIC/PRIOR: Microphone priority switch.
22. MEDIA: Press MULTIMEDIA to play the tracks in the USB.
23. 0-9 Number keys : When playing songs or videos using USB or TF card, you can use the number keys to select the song or video you want to play.
24. RETURN: Go back to the previous scene when the music movie is playing.
25. ENTER: Select OK or Enter Key.
26. ► : Right direction key/Fast Forward Key.
27. ◀ : Left direction key/Fast Rewind Key.
28. ▲ : Next song or step.
29. ▼ : Previous song or step.






2: Settings/SETUP: Press the SETUP key on the remote control directly to enter Settings, or press the direction keys to light the Settings icon. Press OK key to enter the selected page.




After entering the Settings, press the Direction key to choose WIFI and to choose your network. Press the OK key and enter the Password to connect to the network.




3. Press the direction key to Choose the Bluetooth icon. Press OK key to enter. Open the BT function in your mobile device and choose the relative BT name to connect. Press PREV/NEXT to choose songs. Press PLAY/PAUSE key to play or pause the song.




4. Plug in the USB Flash Drive or TF Card and It will play automatically. Press the EXIT key to choose your desired track and press OK key to play. Press EXIT again to show the following main page to alter Video & Music.



5. Press direction keys to choose “My App” icon on the main page. Press confirm to Enter. It will show the installed APP. Follow the picture for reference.



6. Explore: Plugging in the USB & TF card, use direction key to select the Explore icon to play the contents in the USB/TF card.
7. Record:
- Use direction key to choose the Record icon, and press the OK key of the remote control to start recording. Press OK again to stop. Press the Direction Key to select Finish. Last, press OK key to preserve your recorded file.
  - Select the recorded file, and press the MENU key to select Delete. Press OK key to delete your recorded file.
8. YouTube is a video website. You could only browse and watch after getting connected to the internet.
9. Google Play is an application store, just like App Store, by which you could install applications via the internet.



## 6 - GUÍA DE CONFIGURACIÓN DE PASOS

Paso **1** Busque el cable de alimentación de CA a la centralita KAR-929 que se encuentra en el paquete.


Paso **2** Busque una toma de corriente (CA 120V / 60Hz) y conecte el adaptador de CA al enchufe para suministrar energía a la unidad.

Paso **3** Muévase a la parte superior del panel y presione y mantenga presionado el botón POWER INPUT. La unidad debe encenderse y comenzar a cargarse.

Paso **4** Inserte una unidad flash USB en el puerto USB ubicado junto a la perilla de volumen. El KAR-929 comenzará a reproducir automáticamente el contenido .mp3.

Paso **5** Utilice la perilla de volumen para ajustar el volumen general a su gusto. Use la perilla de volumen del micrófono para subir el micrófono.

Paso **6** Pulse las teclas Adelante y Rebobinar para pasar a la siguiente pista o pista anterior. Si está en modo FM, estas teclas cambiarán la estación de radio.



### KAR-929 BLUETOOTH

Modo Bluetooth: use el botón MODE para habilitar Bluetooth en el KAR-929. Abra la configuración de Bluetooth en su dispositivo móvil y busque QFX KAR-929. Seleccione la opción para emparejar ambos dispositivos. Ahora puede sentarse y disfrutar de la música de su aplicación favorita. No necesitará volver a conectar el Bluetooth al cambiar de modo.
