



RADIO OPERATION

- 1. Choose Your Band: Use the band switch to select between MP3, FM, AM, SW, or BT.
- 2. Set the Volume: Turn the "TUNING" button to adjust the volume to your desired level.
- 3. Adjust Antenna: Position the antenna for optimal reception.
- 4. Turn Off the Radio: To switch off the radio, turn the "VOLUME" knob to the lowest setting.
- 5. Light Control: Use the lamp switch button to turn the light on and off.

USB/TF OPERATION

- 1. Turn On the Radio: Power on the device.
- 2. Insert USB or TF Card: Insert your USB drive or TF card with your music files.
- 3. Select Music: Use the ◄ or ▶ buttons to navigate through your music selection.
- 4. Play or Pause: Press the ▶ii button to play or pause the music.
- 5. Adjust Volume: Turn volume knob to decrease or increase volume.

BLUETOOTH AUDIO

Select the MP3 BT switch setting. Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device and pair it to "QFX RETRO-15". Once paired, you can stream music from your Bluetooth device and hear it through the radio's speaker.


AUX INPUT







FONCTIONNEMENT RADIO
