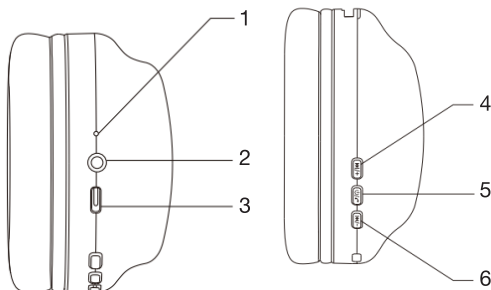

Features

1. Microphone
2. AUX Port
3. Type-C Charging Port
4. Increase Volume / Next Track
5. Power Button / Answer or Hangup Call
6. Decrease Volume / Previous Track



Bluetooth Connection

1. To turn on the headphones, press and hold the  button.
2. Search for the Bluetooth name "QFX HP-20" on your phone's Bluetooth list to pair and connect.
3. Once connected, you can listen to music.

Turn On/Off The Light

Press the "+" button triple times to turn on/off the light

Music Operation

1. Press and hold power button to turn the headphones on
2. Press and hold + button to increase audio volume
Press + button to skip to the next track
3. Press and hold - button to decrease audio volume
Press - button to go back to the previous track

Hands-Free Operation

- Press  button to answer a phone call
Press  button to hang up call
- Press and hold  button to reject an incoming call
- Double press  button to re-dial the last dialed call

FM Radio Operation

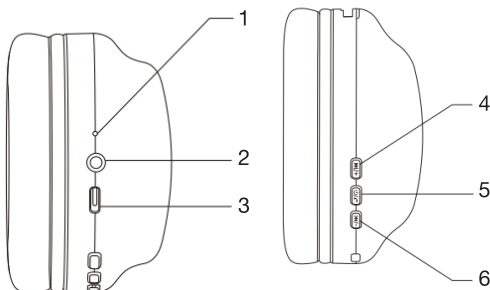
- To Toggle to FM mode press the  button 3 times
- To AUTO-SCAN the stations, press the  button once. It will take a few minutes to scan all the stations. Once all the stations are scanned, they are automatically registered in memory.
- Press + or - to skip registered stations
- Press and hold + or - button to increase or decrease volume

Listening to Music using AUX-In Mode

- Insert the included 3.5mm auxiliary cable into the Aux input of the Headphone. The other end of the cable connects to your audio device, such as a cell phone, computer, or tablet.
- Select your favorite song at the source device and play. (Note: You don't need to turn on the Headphone in this mode. You can control the volume increase/decrease, play/pause, and next/previous track through your source device.)

Características

1. Micrófono
2. Puerto AUX
3. Puerto de carga tipo C
4. Subir volumen / Pista siguiente
5. Botón de encendido / Responder o colgar llamada
6. Bajar volumen / Pista anterior



Conexión Bluetooth

1. Para encender los auriculares, mantén pulsado el botón .
2. Busca el nombre de Bluetooth "QFX HP-20" en la lista de Bluetooth de tu teléfono para emparejarlos y conectarlos.
3. Una vez conectados, podrás escuchar música.

Encender/apagar la luz

Presione el botón "+" tres veces para encender/apagar la luz.

Operación musical

1. Mantenga presionado el botón de encendido para encender los auriculares.
2. Mantenga presionado el botón + para aumentar el volumen. Presione el botón + para pasar a la siguiente pista.
3. Mantenga presionado el botón - para disminuir el volumen. Presione el botón - para volver a la pista anterior.

Operación manos libres

- Presione el botón  para contestar una llamada telefónica. Presione el botón  para colgar la llamada.
- Mantenga presionado el botón  para rechazar una llamada entrante.
- Presione dos veces el botón  para volver a marcar la última llamada realizada.

Operación de radio FM

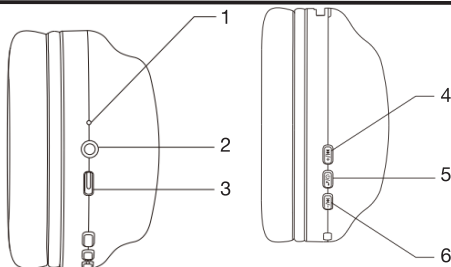
- Para cambiar al modo FM, pulse el botón  3 veces.
- Para AUTOBUSCAR las emisoras, pulse el botón  una vez. El escaneo tardará unos minutos. Una vez escaneadas, se registrarán automáticamente en la memoria.
- Pulse + o - para omitir las emisoras registradas.
- Mantenga pulsado el botón + o - para subir o bajar el volumen.

Cómo escuchar música usando el modo AUX-In

- Inserta el cable auxiliar de 3,5 mm incluido en la entrada auxiliar de los auriculares. El otro extremo del cable se conecta a tu dispositivo de audio, como un teléfono móvil, una computadora o una tableta.
- Selecciona tu canción favorita en el dispositivo fuente y reproducela. (Nota: No es necesario encender los auriculares en este modo. Puedes controlar el volumen, la reproducción, la pausa y la pista siguiente o anterior a través del dispositivo fuente).

Connexion Bluetooth

1. Pour allumer le casque, maintenez le bouton  enfoncé.
2. Recherchez le nom Bluetooth « QFX HP-20 » dans la liste Bluetooth de votre téléphone pour l'appairer et vous connecter.
3. Une fois connecté, vous pouvez écouter de la musique.

Allumer/Éteindre la lumière

Appuyez trois fois sur le bouton « + » pour allumer/éteindre la lumière.

Opération Musique

1. Appuyez longuement sur le bouton d'alimentation pour allumer le casque.
2. Appuyez longuement sur le bouton + pour augmenter le volume. Appuyez longuement sur le bouton + pour passer au morceau suivant.
3. Appuyez longuement sur le bouton - pour baisser le volume. Appuyez longuement sur le bouton - pour revenir au morceau précédent.

Fonctionnement mains libres

- Appuyez sur le bouton  pour répondre à un appel. Appuyez sur le bouton  pour raccrocher.
- Appuyez longuement sur le bouton  pour rejeter un appel entrant.
- Appuyez deux fois sur le bouton  pour recomposer le dernier numéro composé.

Fonctionnement de la radio FM

- Pour passer en mode FM, appuyez 3 fois sur le bouton .
 - Pour effectuer une recherche automatique des stations, appuyez une fois sur le bouton .
- La recherche prend quelques minutes. Une fois toutes les stations recherchées, elles sont automatiquement enregistrées en mémoire.
- Appuyez sur + ou - pour ignorer les stations enregistrées.
 - Maintenez le bouton + ou - enfoncé pour augmenter ou diminuer le volume.

Écouter de la musique en mode AUX-In

- Insérez le câble auxiliaire 3,5 mm fourni dans l'entrée auxiliaire du casque. L'autre extrémité se connecte à votre appareil audio, tel qu'un téléphone portable, un ordinateur ou une tablette.
- Sélectionnez votre morceau préféré sur l'appareil source et lancez la lecture. (Remarque : il n'est pas nécessaire d'allumer le casque dans ce mode. Vous pouvez contrôler l'augmentation/la diminution du volume, la lecture/pause et le passage au morceau suivant/précédent depuis votre appareil source.)

Warranty Period encompasses, as listed below, separate "Coverage Periods" for Parts and Labor, each Coverage Period to begin from the original date of Customer purchase. If Customer returns a defective Product (or any component thereof) during the applicable Warranty Period, QFX will, at its option, during the specified Coverage Periods for Parts and Labor (as applicable either: (i) repair the Product (or, as applicable, any component thereof) or (ii) replace the Product (or, as applicable, any component thereof) with a new or refurbished Product (or, as applicable, any component thereof), in either case free of charge to Customer for Parts and/or Labor (as applicable) during the specified Coverage Period only, and excluding applicable shipping charges (noted below), for which the Customer is responsible.
